



Player's Code of Conduct

Players are expected to comply with the following:

1. I understand that it is a privilege to play organized sports and that I represent my team, my family and my community during a recreation sponsored activity. I will always be a good sport no matter the outcome of a contest.
2. I will treat the coach, referee, spectators, other players and opponents with respect.
3. I will not use profanity or obscene/obnoxious/abusive language during a recreation sponsored activity. I will not trash talk or make any kind of derogatory remarks to our opponents. I will not use any form of intimidating behavior or bullying tactics.
4. I will wish opponents good luck before the game and always shake their hand following a game.
5. I will respect the judgment of game officials and abide by their decisions without complaint. I will never argue with an official.
6. I will always watch out for other members of my team and help those in need.
7. I will win with modesty and lose with grace. I will do both with honor, and avoid inappropriate celebrating after a play or at the end of a game.

Failure to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines can/will result in disciplinary action.

Inappropriate behavior by a participant will result in the following:

- 1st Incident: The participant, or if the participant is under 18 years of age, their parent or guardian, and coach will received written notification of the first incident from their coach.
- 2nd Incident: The participant, if under 18 years of age along with their parent or guardian, will be suspended required to appear before the appropriate Sports Board and/or Recreation Commission Board for consideration of reinstatement into the program.
- 3rd Incident: The participant will be permanently suspended or expelled from the program, event or facility. If a participant engages in behavior which poses a threat of bodily harm to himself of others, an immediate meeting may be called or, based on the severity of the incident; the individual will be immediately suspended or expelled from the program or facility and local law enforcement authorities notified.
